The Council requires two identity documents.

One must be a photo ID. A minimum of one document must come from **Category A**. Documents accepted for name change cannot be used to verify primary identity.

Note: If a Birth Certificate is being used as a Name Change document, it must show **both** birth name and married name. A Marriage/Civil Union Certificate must be dated after the Marriage/Civil Union has occurred.

Documents must be certified and sent by postal mail. Please do not send originals. Certification of the copy can only be done by a solicitor, a Notary Public, a Justice of the Peace, or another person authorised to take a statutory declaration.
